### EYFS

This week we have continued to learn about the adventures of 'SUPERTATO'. We have looked at the setting of the story - a supermarket, and explored what we already know about supermarkets. We have learnt all about the number 2 and have explored different ways of showing 2 such as marks, objects and actions. We also enjoyed having our parents and carers in for a Phonics session.

### Year 1

Each class has now taken part in two days of Forest Schools where they made their own medals out of wood, practised putting up a camping tent as well as making beautiful fairy dens using natural resources from around our outdoor environment.
