Property Update and Reminders

Over half term we have installed a new canopy at the front of the school. This is in response to parent feedback about shelter from the weather when waiting for school events.

May I remind all parents/carers...

- it is your responsibility to supervise your child before and after school.
- all adults on the school site should behave appropriately. Any inappropriate behaviour towards staff, other adults and children will NOT be tolerated.
- please park sensibly and respectfully when dropping off/picking up from school. Please ensure you adhere to any road markings and parking restrictions. The Methodist Church allow us to use their car park but please DO NOT park on the grass areas.
