EYFS

This week we listened to the story 'The Selfish Crocodile' and thought about how the crocodile should have behaved. We also thought about how the crocodile could look after his teeth so they don't fall out - the children were very good at knowing he should brush his teeth twice a day! We have continued to learn about animals and have looked at information texts to find finds about different African animals. We have also started to learn how to count in 5's and 10's.

Year 1

This week in Religious Education we have been exploring the core belief of Sikhism and learning the importance of responsibility. We have also learned about the significance of meditation and thinking to a Sikh and how this makes a difference to family life.

Each class has also enjoyed a session on the 'Book Bus' to further develop our love of reading.

Year 2

We have been thinking about life cycles in Science. We have been researching some less common animals such as turtles, crocodiles and kangaroos to find out each stage of their lives. Interestingly, we found out that some animals start life as an egg, then become hatchlings before growing into adults where the cycle starts all over again. We made some super presentations on the iPads to share what we learnt with others.
