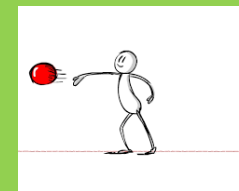


**Now Spring is here, lets exercise!**

# Maths - EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2

## Material Measure

How many crayons long do you think my arm is?

Collect sticks, straws, leaves, socks... you could use anything!

How many leaves long is my leg?

Children can explore how long their arms, legs, feet, fingers are.

Now measure your families, are they as long as yours?



# Maths - EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2

## Challenge

I think the longest toy will be the heaviest, do you agree?

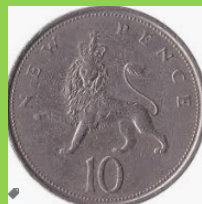
**EYFS**— Which toy is the longest? Pick 3 toys and measure them by putting them side by side.

**Year 1**— How many ways can you make 8?

$$\square + \square = \square$$

I think there are 9 ways, do you agree?

**Year 2**— How many ways can you make 40p using silver coins?



I think there are 8 ways, do you agree?

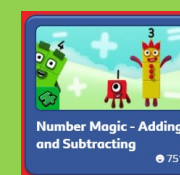
